

GRADING SYSTEM OF ESIEE PARIS

EVALUATION OF COURSE UNITS

For each course unit, a grade representing the level of skills acquired is determined: from A to E, or FX, or F.

A: Excellent: the student acquired more than 90% of the target skills

B: Very good: the student acquired more than 80% of the target skills

C: Good: the student acquired more than 70% of the target skills

D: Quite good: the student acquired more than 60% of the target skills

E: Average: the student acquired more than 50% of the target skills

FX: Inadequate; additional work is required

F: Very inadequate; it is necessary to relearn the basics.

Once the evaluation of a course unit has produced a mark, the two indicators (the mark and the position) are given to the students.
